Drogi Czytelniku!

Jeżeli przygotowujesz się do matury lub innych egzaminów z języka angielskiego na poziomie podstawowym, a zadania poświęcone znajomości środków językowych sprawiają Ci trudność, w pierwszej części książki, którą masz przed sobą, znajdziesz wiele zadań tego typu. Będą one dla Ciebie dobrym treningiem przed egzaminami.

Jeżeli przygotowujesz się do matury na poziomie rozszerzonym lub po prostu jesteś miłośnikiem języka angielskiego i chcesz zgłębiać jego tajniki dla czystej przyjemności bądź po to, aby przygotować się do egzaminów międzynarodowych, np. Cambridge First Certificate, zajrzyj również do drugiej części tej książki. Zostały tam umieszczone zadania z zakresu środków językowych występujące na poziomie rozszerzonym, a także tzw. duale, czyli słowa o podwójnym znaczeniu, ale w wersji trudniejszej niż w części pierwszej podręcznika – bez podpowiedzi A, B, C. Tutaj to jedno odpowiednie słowo musisz odgadnąć tylko na podstawie zestawu dwóch zdań, do których ono pasuje. Pamiętaj, że w obu zdaniach musi mieć ono tę samą formę. Takie ćwiczenie to świetny trening ogólnych umiejętności językowych. Podobnie części zwane „one word” lub „uzupełnianie luk jednym słowem” zostały umieszczone w części pierwszej podręcznika w wersji spotykanej na poziomie podstawowym matury, czyli z podpowiedziami A, B, C, a w części drugiej – w wersji bez podpowiedzi, jaką znajdziemy zarówno na maturze rozszerzonej, jak i na egzaminie Cambridge First Certificate.

Ćwiczenia zawarte w obu częściach książki pomogą Ci ugruntować wiedzę nie tylko z zakresu gramatyki, ale również leksyki:

- zadania ze słowotwórstwa rozwinią zasób słownictwa i sprawdzą poprawność ortograficzną,
- tzw. duale pomogą zgłębić wiedzę z zakresu leksyki,
- uzupełnianie luk w tekście rozbuduje znajomość języka angielskiego,
- minidialogi sprawdzą, czy reagujesz w zrozumiały sposób, adekwatnie do sytuacji komunikacyjnej,
- tworzenie parafrasz wzbogaci Twoje wypowiedzi i poszerzy różnorodność konstrukcji językowych,
- tłumaczenia umocnią pewność siebie w przekazywaniu informacji,
- dopasowywanie synonimów zweryfikuje znajomość znaczenia wyrazów,
- uzupełnianie zdań pomoże ocenić przygotowanie pod kątem gramatycznym.

Tak więc, drogi Czytelniku, masz przed sobą materiały, które umożliwią Ci sprawdzanie i zgłębianie wiedzy z zakresu języka angielskiego na różnych poziomach, a nam jako autorom pozostaje życzyć Ci, by Twoja wiedza sięgnęła co najmniej poziomu zadań z drugiej części naszej książki. 
